### **Dinners and Milk**

Just a reminder that the current cost of a school dinner is **£2.40** per child for the children in the juniors. All children in the Infant class are entitled to a Universal Free School Meal until they join the junior class. Milk costs are **15p** per child per day. If you would like to pay for your child's dinners in advance the cost for the next half term (30th April till 24<sup>th</sup> May) are as follows

•	Dinners	-	£43.20	18 days at £2.40 a day
•	Milk	-	£ 2.70	18 days at 15p a day

For those of you wishing to pay weekly we ask that the dinner money is sent into school in a named purse or envelope on a Monday. Thank you.

# Breakfast Club/ Arriving at School
