School Uniform

Lots of children have lovely new school uniform but already we have noticed that some of it is not yet named. Please could you make sure that you have popped your child's name on all items of clothing, including shoes, for both uniform and PE. Thank you.

Dinner money and milk

When children move from Y2 up to Y3, the government funded Universal Free School Meals come to an end. For all junior children, there is a charge of £2.40 per day for a school dinner. There is also the option for the children to have milk to drink at break time each day. The cost of this is 15p per day. Please complete the attached form to let us know if you wish your child to have milk. Dinner and milk money should be paid weekly to the school office on a Monday morning please. If you would prefer to pay once every half term please see Kelly in the school office to arrange this.

Breakfast Club/ Arriving at School

Just a little reminder that Breakfast Club is still running in school from 8am till 9am every day. The cost is £2.50 per child each morning. If you would like to book your children in for this please call in or give us a ring.

Please can we ask that children not using Breakfast Club do not arrive at school until 8.45am when a member of staff is formally on duty. Should you require your child to arrive earlier at school please make use of our Breakfast Club. Children arriving before 8.45am will be placed into Breakfast Club and charges will be applied as appropriate. Please respect that our staff do need lesson preparation time prior to school starting. Thank you.
