Egton School Return to School for Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 pupils

As you know there has been a suggested date of 1st June for the return to school of Reception, Y1 and Y6. The government has informed us that they will advise us further on 28th May and we await the outcome of their decision. Our Governing Body as a Voluntary Aided School will then decide, based on the information at that time, if Egton school is able to proceed with a safe opening and we will confirm our positon with you on Friday 29th May.

As we prepare to open our doors after the lockdown in March, we are conscious of the level of worry and anxiety that children, parents and staff face. With this in mind we are planning to make the school as safe and as normal a place as possible. We are following the guidance set out for us from the Department for Education website. To help you as a parent we have tried to put all this guidance into context for our school and have attached a draft Parent Guidance Sheet of 'dos and don'ts'. Please note that this guidance stands for the information we have received to date and may be subject to change. We will be sending out a child friendly version of some of this guidance next week for you to share with your child/ren. This is so that your child will know what to expect before they return to school.

Please be assured that in all of our decision making processes, the health, safety and well-being of the children and staff have always been uppermost in our minds.

Half term Contact

As it is half term next week we will not be sending out Learning Packs on Monday and teachers will not be checking their work emails. However, we remain contactable throughout half term via the admin@egton.n-yorks.sch.uk email address should you need to speak to us or if you are a key worker and require urgent childcare.
