Please can we remind all parents that we have a healthy snacks policy in our school. We have noticed a significant number of children bringing chocolate and sweets for their snack or in their lunchboxes. These items are discouraged and we respectfully request that these items are not brought into school. Please do remember that you are able to order Milk for your child at breaktime and we also encourage children to bring their own healthy snacks to eat at that time. For most of our children it is a long time from breakfast time to lunchtime and we find that they are able to concentrate and learn better with a mid-morning snack and drink. We suggest snacks such as fruit (dried or fresh), crackers and cheese, potato snacks or a sandwich. We ask that you do not send sweets or chocolate biscuits. Most children also bring a plastic bottle, or carton, containing fruit juice or water. We ask that you do not send fizzy drinks, glass bottles or cans. Thank you.
